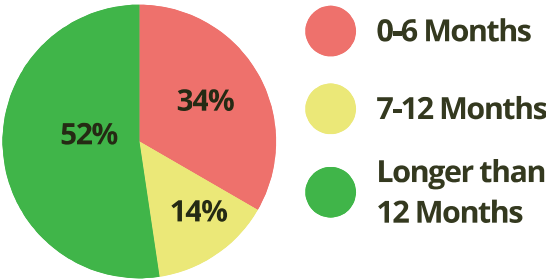

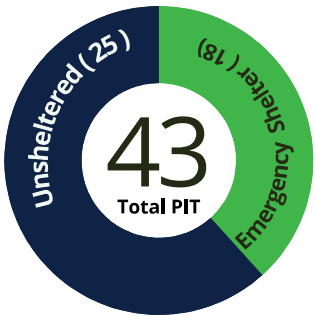

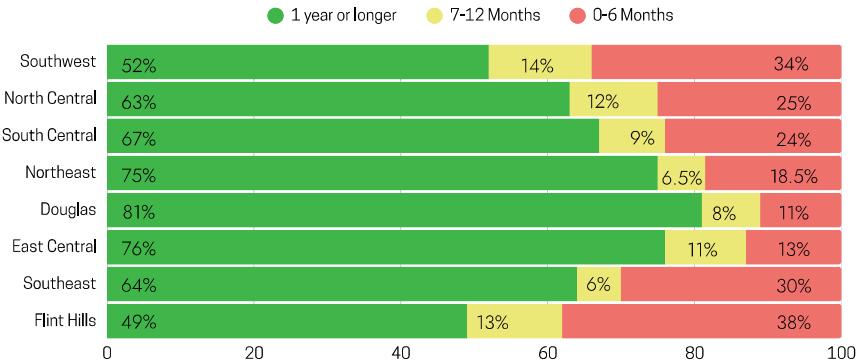

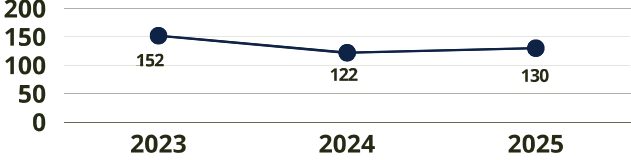

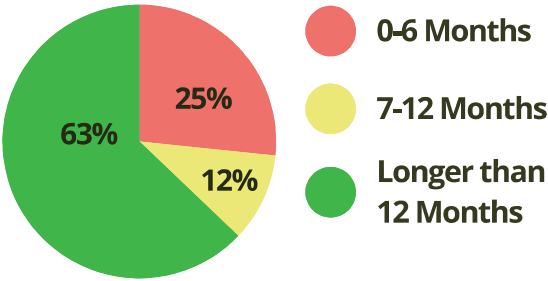

## HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN IN THIS CURRENT COUNTY?



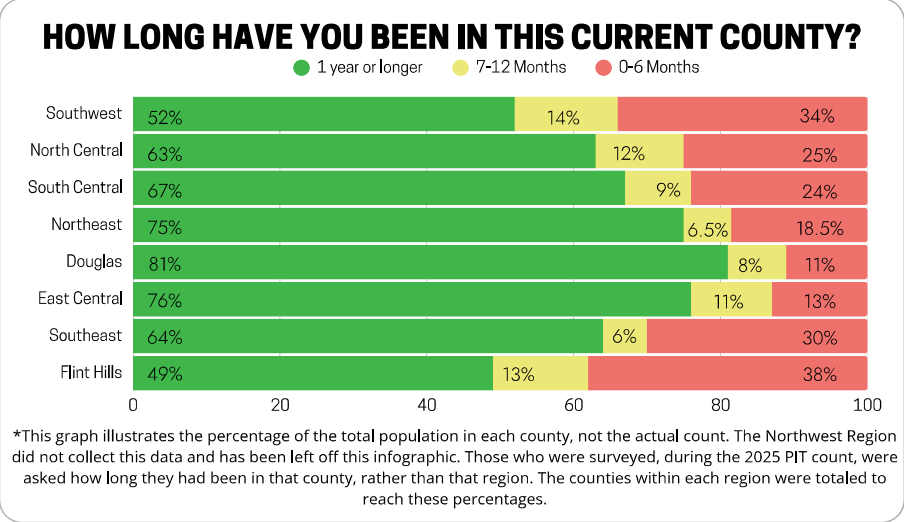
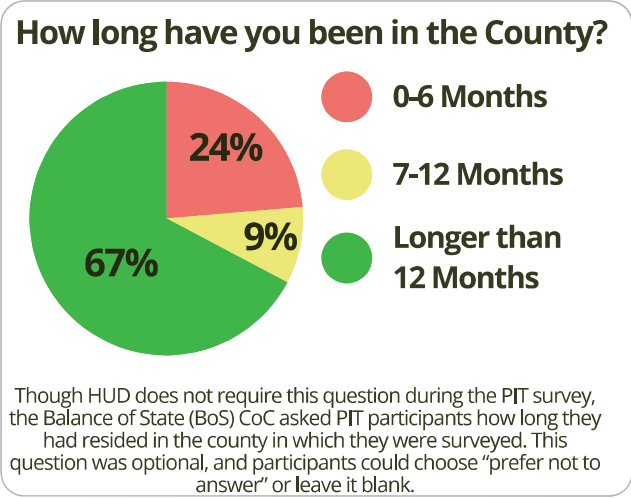

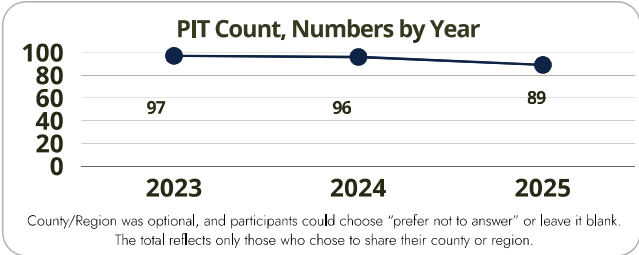

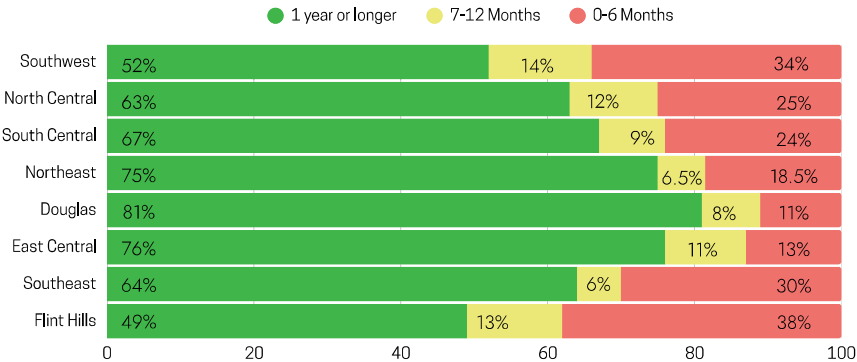

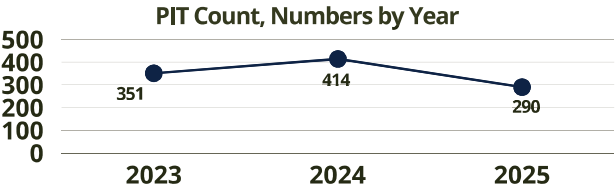

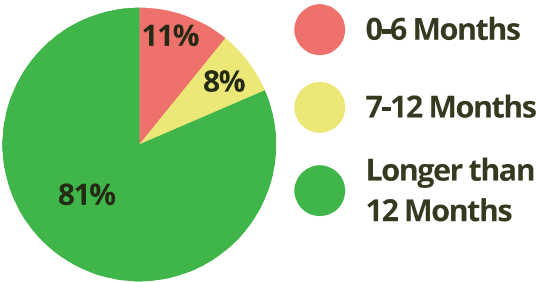

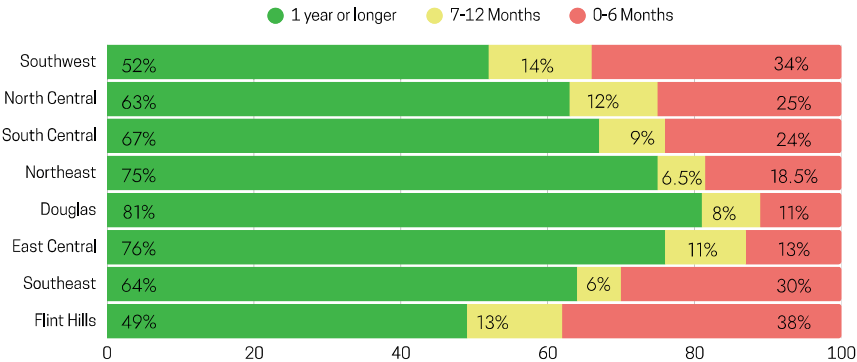

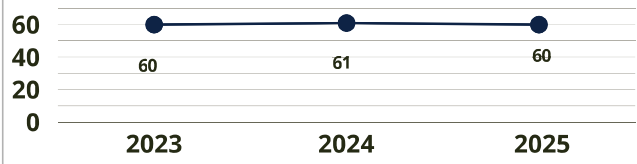

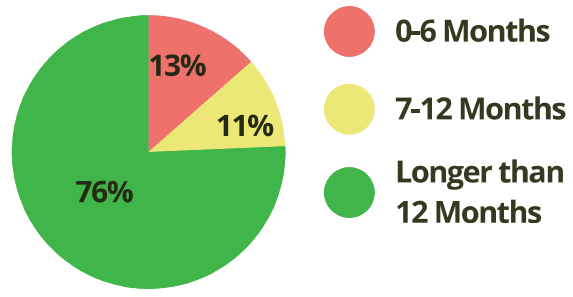

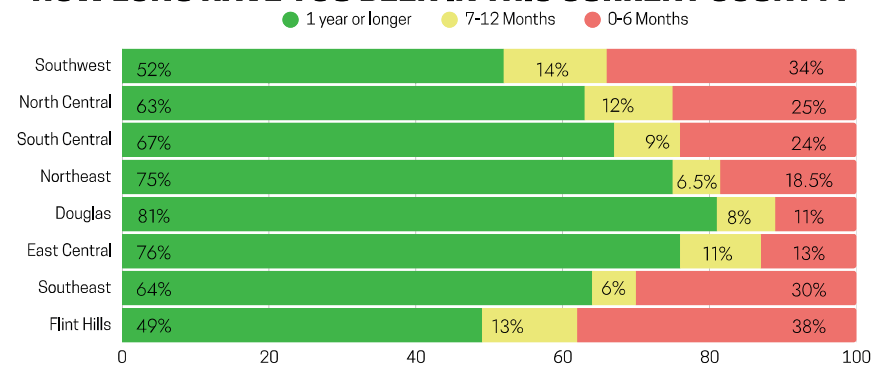

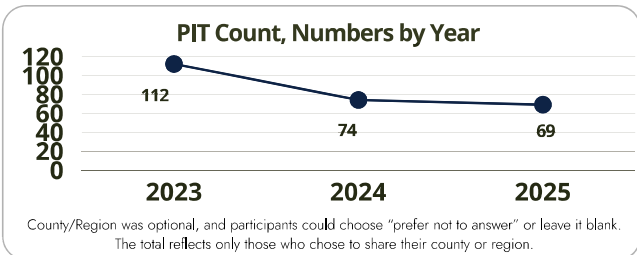

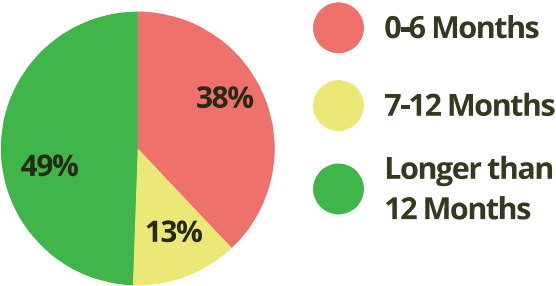

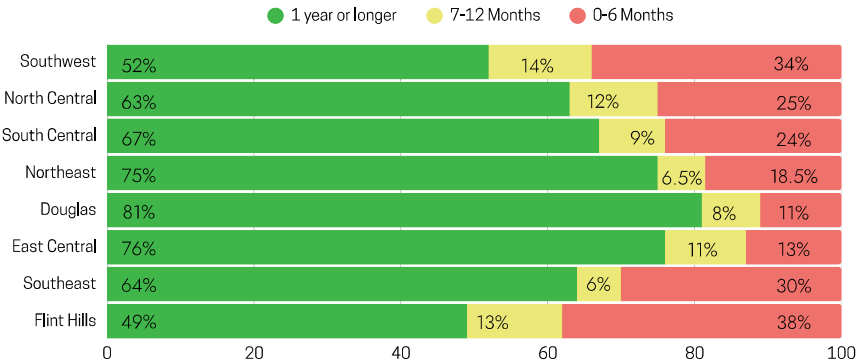

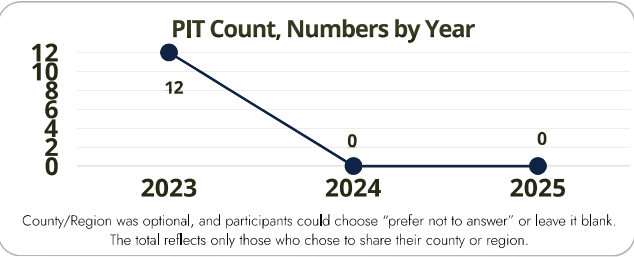

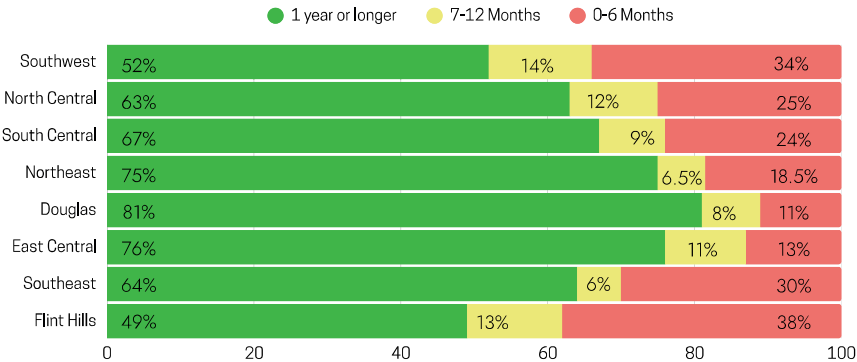
